CIRCULAR

**Subject: Regarding Pre-Matric scholarship scheme and Post-Matric Scholarship schemes for Minority students for the year 2021-22 (Centrally Sector Scheme) on National Scholarship Portal (NSP).**

A Video Conference (V.C.) meeting of Pr. Secretaries (Education) of all States/UTs was convened under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA), Govt. of India (Gol) on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 to review the progress of the implementation of Pre-Matric scholarship scheme and Post-Matric scholarship schemes for minority students. The Secretary, MoMA, Gol has shown displeasure on very poor performance regarding Aadhaar Authentication of Institute Nodal Officer (INO) of all type of schools (Govt, Govt Aided, Recognized Unaided Private Schools, Local body Schools, and KVS) **which is mandatory w.e.f. 2021-22 academic session otherwise INOs will not be able for online verification of applications in r/o Pre-Matric scholarship scheme and Post-Matric scholarship scheme for minority students and in this case the applicant student will be deprived of his/her scholarship. For such cases of non-verification of applications at school level, the responsibility of failure will lie on the defaulting Head of School/INO and concerned DDE (zones).**

In above said reference, a circular bearing No. F.No. DE.18-3 (19)/PLG/2021-22/2593-2599 dated 21.10.2021 and e-mails dated 21.10.2021 & 25.10.2021 have already been issued. In this regard, **the Director (Education) has Chaired a meeting of all DDEs (zones) on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2021** in the Conference Room of DoE, Old Sectt and **they were directed to ensure that all INOs of all type of schools under their jurisdiction must be immediately Aadhaar Authenticated on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) to become eligible for online verification of application on NSP.**

At last, all concerned are informed that the Secretary, MoMA, Gol will again review the status of Pre-Matric scholarship scheme and Post-Matric scholarship scheme for minority student in the **first week of November, 2021.** Therefore, all Head of Schools are directed to take up said issue **on Top Priority** by ensuring Aadhaar Authentication of INOs of all type of school within **three days from the date of this circular.**

Annexure-I

Actions to be taken by the State Governments/UT Administrations related to the implementation of the 3 Scholarship Schemes:

- (i) State Government/UT Administration should publicise the Schemes through advertisements in leading local newspapers and other suitable publicity media in their respective State/UT. The advertisement will enable the minority students to avail the maximum benefits of scholarship schemes. The advertisement should also mention that "All renewal applicants/students, who have got scholarship during 2020-21, shall apply by giving their existing Application ID".
- (ii) All Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools, having valid AISHE/ U-DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes, located in the State/UT should be advised to register themselves and their courses details on the NSP at the earliest so that their students can apply and they can verify such applications on the Portal within the timelines.
- (iii) The timelines need to be adhered to strictly. Technical issue, if any arising during the process of online submission, generation of merit lists and payment lots may be resolved immediately in consultation with the NIC HQ or State NICs at the earliest.
- (iv) It has been observed that after the last date (s) of verification, a large number of Fresh as well as Renewal applications are left pending for verification at L1 level by Institute Nodal Officers and L2 level by State/District Nodal Officers (SNOs/DNOs). All States/UTs are advised to look into this issue and ensure that no application remains unverified after the last date (s) of verification during 2021-22.
- (v) All Verification Authorities (INO/DNO/SNO) can mark an application fake if he/she is satisfied that the applicant is not a bonafide student. In other circumstances, in case of non-fulfillment of eligibility criteria or inconsistency of records, the verifying authority may either reject the application or mark it defective and give the applicant another opportunity to correct their records.
- (vi) It needs to be noted by all the INOs, DNOs and SNOs that in case if any application is marked fake at L2 Level by the DNO or the SNO then the entire bunch of applications from that School/Institute will go back to the respective INO login of that School/Institute for re-verification. Hence the DNOs/SNOs are advised to exercise caution while using the option of marking an application fake.
- (vii) In addition to the above, all State Governments/UT Administrations may note the following for necessary compliance as requested vide this Ministry's letter No.15/13/2020-SS dated 02.08.2021 a copy of which is attached as Annex-II.
  - a. Aadhaar based demographic authentication of Institute/District/State Nodal Officers.
  - b. The option of rejecting a payment file on the basis of 'fake' applications has been restricted and therefore the SNOs may exercise utmost caution while rejecting payment file on NSP Portal.
  - c. Aadhaar demographic authentication based on applicant's details i.e. name, gender and year of birth as given in Aadhaar, has been introduced on NSP Portal.

### 4.2.2. Institute Nodal Officer

The primary role of the Institute Nodal officer is 1<sup>st</sup> Level verification of the applications submitted by applicants at NSP. The application form for student has been simplified with minimal uploading of scanned documents by students on NSP. Hence, the role of the Institute Nodal officer becomes very critical in the entire chain of verification process. The Institute Nodal officer using NSP must adhere to the following:

#### 1. Institute Registration Process

- a) The Institute/School/ITI shall possess a valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT code, before registering on NSP.
- b) The Institute/School/ITI with valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes can register on NSP. To know whether Institute/School/ITI is registered on NSP Portal or not, go to <https://scholarships.gov.in> and click on "Search Institute/School/ITI".
- c) The Institute/School/ITI, with valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT code and not registered on NSP can request the District or State Nodal Officer, of any Scholarship scheme onboarded on NSP, to add it on NSP.
- d) The District or State Nodal Officer will search for the Institute based on AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT code. In case the institute is not registered, the Nodal Officer can add it by providing the requisite details. The system generated User credentials and password will be sent on the mobile number provided.
- e) Colleges/Universities/Institutes/Schools and any other educational establishments onboarded on NSP shall be referred to as Institutes.

#### 2. Institute Nodal Officer: Registration process

- a) From Academic Year 2019-20 onwards, Institute logging in the first time will have to mandatorily fill the Institute Nodal Officer Registration Form.
- b) The Institute Nodal officer will login on NSP using the user credentials, and complete Institute Nodal Officer Registration Form by entering his/her details and uploading the identify document. The Institute Nodal officer after locking the form using the OTP received, will take the print, paste his/her photograph on the Form, get it attested by the Institute Head (Signature and Institute seal/stamp), will submit the physical form to the respective District/ State/ Ministry Nodal officer of any scheme onboarded on NSP.

- c) The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer will verify the physical form and the details entered in system, and approve/reject the Institute Nodal Officer Registration Form details on NSP using the option "Verify Institute Registration Form" under the Administration section in his login. The User credentials and new password will be sent to the registered mobile number of the Institute Nodal officer. The original physical copy of the form should be kept with District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer and a duplicate copy is to be shared with Institute Nodal officer, who shall keep the same in Institute's records.
- d) The institute Nodal officer can login using the new User credentials, password and OTP received on his/her mobile number. The concerned officer can reset the password by clicking the "Forgot Password" on Institute Login page on NSP.
- e) For the cases of registration, where previous Institute Nodal has been transferred and has not provided the login credentials to the new Institute Nodal Officer, the new Institute Nodal Officer shall formally request District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer to change the mobile number and send the login credentials to the new mobile number. The new Nodal Officer is responsible for updating the profile with his/her credentials.
- f) In case the new Institute Nodal Officer has access to the previous Nodal Officer, the registered mobile number can be changed by existing Nodal Officer. The system asks for the OTP on previous mobile number and the new mobile number to be registered. The existing Nodal Officer is also primarily responsible for updating the profile with credentials of the new Nodal Officer.

### **3. Institute Nodal Officer: Profile updation**

- a) The Institute Nodal Officer shall submit the Institute details in the profile, and select the Course Levels offered by the Institute.
- b) The Institute Nodal Officer shall ensure that the profile details of the Institute are updated from time to time.
- c) The Institute Nodal Officer shall submit the correct bank account details of the Institute.
- d) The Institute Nodal Officer shall update the offered courses and course fee charged for each course Level.
- e) The Institute Nodal Officer shall regularly change the password.
- f) The Institute Nodal Officer shall ensure that the profile is updated profile with the details of the New Nodal officer before updating the mobile number and email ID, in case of change of Nodal officer.

#### 4. 1<sup>st</sup> Level Verification Process & Steps

- a) The Institute Nodal officer must verify the correctness of details in the application form and uploaded documents submitted by the student/ applicant, and maintain physical copies of supporting documents submitted by the student/ applicant. The District/State/Ministry Nodal Officer can ask for copies of these documents from the Institute Nodal Officers, as and when required.
- b) The Institute Nodal officer has the option to either Verify the application, Reject the application or Defect the application. In case she/he chooses to Reject or Defect the application, the reasons for rejection or defect must be provided, so that the same can be displayed to the student/applicant.
- c) The Application defected by the Institute will be returned to student/applicant for correcting the same, and once submitted by the student/applicant, the application will be shown under Reverification section of NSP application.
- d) The Institute Nodal Officer shall ensure that appropriate due diligence is done before verification of applications in accordance with the Scheme guidelines, and internal procedure as prescribed by Institute authorities / Government are followed.
- e) The Institute Nodal Officer shall ensure that the applications are scrutinized well-in-time by the Institute, thus avoiding the last-minute rush to verify the applications.
- f) The Institute Nodal Officer shall ensure that there are no pending applications, as on last date of L1 verification for that particular scheme, and all applications submitted by students/applicants to the Institute are scrutinized (verified/rejected/defected along with appropriate reason, as the case may be).
- g) The Institute Nodal Officer can mark any application as Fake at any stage before the payment is made, using the option "Mark as Fake" under the Verification section in his/her profile, in case a fraud is suspected in the application.

#### 4.2.3. District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer

The primary role of District/ State/ Ministry Nodal officer is 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Level verification (as per the scheme guidelines) of the applications submitted at NSP and verified by Institutes. The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal officer using NSP must comply with the following-

##### 1. District/ State level Nodal Officer User Creation Process

- a) The login credentials for State Nodal Officers are created when the Ministry Nodal officers create the user for State. The Ministry Nodal officer enters the following details

to create the State user – State Name, State Nodal Officer Name, Designation, Mobile No., Email ID and Address of the State Nodal Officer. Once these details are entered in the system, a unique User name is generated by the system, and username and password is sent to the mobile no. of State Nodal Officer as registered by the Ministry Nodal officer.

- b) The login credentials for District Nodal Officers are created when the State Nodal officers create the user for District. The State Nodal officer enters the following details to create the District user – District Name, District Nodal Officer Name, Designation, Mobile No., Email ID and Address of the District Nodal Officer. Once these details are entered in the system, a unique User name is generated by the system, and username and password is sent to the mobile no. of District Nodal Officer as registered by the State Nodal officer.
- c) In case of change in District Nodal officer, she/he shall approach the State Nodal Officer with a request to reset the password and change mobile number.
- d) Similarly, in case of State Nodal Officer, she/he shall approach Ministry level Nodal officer with a request to reset the password and change mobile number.

## **2. District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer: Adding / Verification of Institute(s)**

- a) The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer reset the password of a registered Institute using the option “Reset Institute Login Password” under the Administration section in his/her profile. He/She shall search for the Institute using Institute Name or AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT Code. He/She can select the Institute from the list displayed in search results, and click on reset the password. He/She also has the facility to change the mobile number of Institute Nodal Officer through this option, so that the OTP is received on the mobile number of current officer.
- b) The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer can add new Institute using the option “Add Institute/School” under the Administration section in his/her profile. He/She shall search for the Institute using Institute Name or AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT Code. If the Institute is already registered, the District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer can reset the password. If Institute is not registered, he/she can register the Institute and create User credentials of the Institute by providing details such as Institute Nodal Officer Name and Mobile number. The User credentials will be generated by the system, and will be sent as an SMS to the provided mobile number. The Institute Nodal Officer can then proceed for the Institute Nodal Officer registration as per the process.

- c) The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer shall ensure that the Institute Nodal Officer registration is approved on the NSP portal after physically verifying the certified Institute Registration form submitted by the Institute Nodal Officer, along with photograph and identity proof.

### 3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Verification Process & Steps

- a) The District/ State/ Ministry Nodal Officer shall verify the correctness of details in the application form and uploaded documents submitted by the student/applicant as per guidelines of the related scheme.
- b) The District / State / Ministry Level Nodal officer can either Verify the application, Defect the Application, Reject the applications or Mark the application as Fake. In case she/he chooses to Defect the Application, Reject the application or Mark the application as fake, the reasons must be provided, so that the same can be displayed to the student/applicant.
- c) The District / State / Ministry Level Nodal officer shall monitor overall pendency of the applications for the scheme at Institute Level.
- d) The District / State / Ministry Level Nodal officer shall ensure that the applications are scrutinized well-in-time by the Institute, thus avoiding the last-minute rush to verify the applications.

### 4. 3<sup>rd</sup> Level Verification Process & Steps

- a) For the schemes that require third level of verification, the State/ Ministry Nodal Officer shall follow the same process as followed for 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Verification.

#### **4.2.4. Scheme owner Ministries / Departments / Other Govt. bodies**

The primary role of the Scheme Owner Ministries/ Departments/Other Govt. bodies is to onboard the scheme at NSP, and monitor the overall progress of the scheme. This includes all three types of schemes, i.e. Central Schemes, Centrally Sponsored Schemes and State Schemes.

The Scheme Owner Ministries/ Departments/ Other Govt. bodies must:

- a) The Scheme Owner Ministries/ Departments/ Other Govt. bodies shall provide confirmation for adherence to the NSP guidelines.
- b) The Scheme Owner Ministries/ Departments/ Other Govt. bodies shall provide Scheme guidelines, Configuration details, FAQs to NIC.

# Dussehra, Durga Puja festivities get go-ahead

## Puja organisers prep for muted celebrations

Organisers will have to ensure the number of people in a venue does not exceed the number of seats, stalls and fairs will not be allowed

**NEW DELHI:** The Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) on Wednesday decided to allow Ramlila, Dussehra and Durga Puja celebrations this year in public places under a set of restrictions. However, the authority is yet to issue an order regarding the decisions taken at Wednesday's meeting.

Organisers will have to ensure the number of people in a venue does not exceed the number of seats, DDMA said, even as it disallowed stalls and fairs. Additionally, organisers have also been asked to ensure there is 100% mask compliance, and separate entry and exit points are provided for, apart from a few other restrictions that the authority will soon notify in a standard operating procedure (SOP) document, said three officials aware of the matter.

Dhruv's lieutenant governor Anil Bajaj on Wednesday said that DDMA will consider allowing schools in the city to resume in-person classes for students of classes 6 to 8 after the festive season.

Bajaj is the chairperson of DDMA to review the COVID-19 situation in Delhi. As suggested by the experts, it was decided to consider opening middle school classes 6, after the festive season. All the stakeholders were called upon to work in a coordinated manner towards ensuring adequate preparedness for tackling any future challenges.

DDMA and CM Arvind Kejriwal is its vice-chairperson. "In the wake of the upcoming festive season, Delhi Police and the district administration will ensure 100% mask compliance, appropriate behaviour enforcement and take care that gatherings during the festive season are strictly in compliance with the laid-down SOP, that include no standing crowds, separate entry and exit points, appropriate social distancing for seating, no activities (like fairs, stalls and giant wheel etc) that attract crowds in violation of social distancing and ensure SOPs for ensuring 50% occupancy," said a senior official in Raj Nivas who was present in Wednesday's meeting.

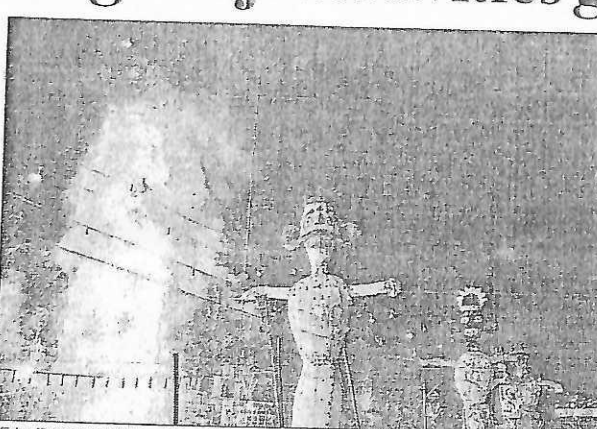
The decisions came as the Capital's Covid-19 caseload is at its lowest levels since the outbreak of the pandemic in March last year. Delhi on Wednesday added 41 Covid-19 cases at a positivity rate of 0.06%, and no deaths.

The city added an average of 34 cases each day over the past seven days, even as the most positive rate continued to remain below the 0.1% mark since early since mid-August. The city has added just five deaths of the infection so far this month.

Last year, the DDMA prohibited Durga Puja committees from organising public celebrations, and Ramlila committees were asked to opt for live streaming. Burning of effigies in Dussehra was allowed in a few locations, with restrictions on the size of crowds.

Arjun Kumar, general secretary of Luv Kush Ramleela committee, said, "We met government officials several times in the past few weeks and assured them that we will ensure all safety regulations are followed. We are happy that the government has trusted us. However, we will continue to live stream the Ramleela on social media and have tied up with cable operators too."

Rubin Bose, general secretary of the Durga Puja committee in Kashmere Gate, said, "We will ensure that all regulations are strictly adhered to. Safety of people comes first. We hope that the process of taking permission from the police and sub-divisional magistrate's office is expedited too."

## Preparations in full swing as Ramlila groups greet green light for festivities

**NEW DELHI:** With the Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) on Wednesday giving the nod to hold Ramlila celebrations, a few organising committees said they were quite ready and happy to hold the Ramlila this year, and compensate for the loss of festivities last year.

Others said the celebrations this year, too, will be muted, as the pandemic threat is yet to abate. According to the DDMA, Ramlila organisers will have to ensure that the number of people does not exceed the venue's total seating capacity, and that no stalls or fairs are set up. They should also ensure 100% mask compliance, and have separate entry/exit points for visitors. These conditions are similar to those laid down for Durga Puja

parades, which were also allowed by the DDMA on Wednesday. A few other restrictions are likely, and the DDMA is expected to notify these in the coming days.

Arjun Kumar, secretary, Luv Kush Ramleela Committee, which organises the Ramleela on the Red Fort grounds, said they are fully prepared for the celebrations. "Our tents have reached the ground and we will start work on the light and sound arrangements on Thursday. Artists from Mumbai will start arriving soon," said Kumar.

He said the preparations are more this year, as festivities could not take place last year due to Covid-19. "Dance groups will put up special performances and the stage theme will be changed daily," said Kumar. He said after discussions with officials, it was decided that

there will be six-feet space between chairs for the audience, and only 50% of the ground capacity will be allowed. "We will aim for 25-30% occupancy to ensure compliance with Covid-19 protocols," said Kumar.

Also, only vaccinated individuals and artists will be allowed to enter the premises, the committee said. The committee has tied up with television channels and a few music outlets for live streaming the Ramlila.

Dhiraj Dhar Gupta, general secretary, Sri Dharmik Lila Committee, Lal Qila Maidan, among the oldest committees in Delhi, said, "We are planning to hold the Ramlila in a single day at an auditorium and not on the grounds. Our committee has already decided not to perform Ramleela itself. In a day or two, we will take a final call," said Gupta.

Harish Rawat, general secretary, Sri Ramlila Samiti, GTB Enclave, said while the committee was ready with preparations, it was waiting for the release of the SOP. "The festivities will be held in a new place as a Covid hospital has come up on the grounds where Ramleela used to be held earlier. Our preparations are done and we plan to call artists from Mumbai for the Ramlila," said Rawat.

Some organisers said the permission came too late and they did not have sufficient time for the preparations. Suresh Binal, president of Sri Ramlila Committee Indraprastha Vihar, said "A grand Ramleela will not take place this year. Had the government given permission 15 days ago, we would have organised the Ramleela at the ground. Instead, we will hold a 3-day Ramleela at IPAX Bhawan in IP Extension."

**NEW DELHI:** Durga Puja, which will be celebrated between October 1 and 15 this year, is likely to be a low-key affair, with most pandal organisers planning to follow the rituals without the associated grandiose such as large idols and cultural programmes, in light of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) met on Wednesday and decided to allow Durga Puja celebrations this year, but with several riders. Unlike last year, when no visitors were allowed at pandals, this year, organisers will have to ensure that venues do not have visitors beyond the seating capacity and there can be no stalls of any kind. "The chief secretary is chalking out a formal standard operating procedure (SOP) for festival celebrations," said a government official who attended the DDMA meeting.

The DDMA organisers are now awaiting the SOP to get more clarity on specific restrictions and relaxations regarding cultural events, idol immersion, pandals, eateries, stalls, and crowd management both inside and outside venues.

"We welcome the decision. We will ensure strict adherence to all regulations. Safety of people is paramount," said Swapan Ganguly, convenor of Kalbari Temple in New Delhi's Mandir Marg, which organises one of the most prominent Durga Puja pandals in the city.

Every year, the police and revenue department issue non-judicial certificates (NOC) to around 550 Durga Puja pandals in the city. Hindustan Times spoke with several of them on Wednesday and most of them said they are left with too little time now to make grand arrangements.

"We plan to have a decent pandal but there will be no idol of cultural programmes," member of the Durga Puja committee at Delhi's Sadajiang Enclave.

Rubin Bose, general secretary of the Durga Puja committee in Kashmere Gate, said, "We welcome the decision but the government has taken too long to make it. We hope the NOC and approval process is expedited."

Between the last Durga Puja and the upcoming one, Delhi has witnessed two major waves of the viral disease — in November 2020 and April 2021. While the first one peaked at a weekly average of 72 cases, the second wave, the April wave peaked at a weekly average of around 25,000 new cases a day.

This year will follow all Covid-19 protocols. However, it's going to be a low-key affair this time with no idol or stalls," said Naryan Dey, general secretary of Durga Puja committee at Ch. Park's Meia Ground.

Till Covid struck, in 2020, the five days of Durga Puja are marked by decorated streets, carnivals, pandal hopping, shopping, neighbourhoods festooned with flowers and lamps, and a wide range of cuisines — offered not only by restaurants, which stretch their working hours during these days, but also makeshift eateries that come up inside and outside venues.

"I am happy that some celebration is happening this time. People will socialise but with adequate precautions. But it is quite impossible to think of Durga Puja without fairs, stalls and cultural programmes," said Shrinji Bhat, a resident of Kalaji, said, "I am happy that we will get to see Durga Puja this year. However, precautions against the viral disease are also necessary. Hopefully, we will be in a better shape next year."
